Monarch Waystation at Palm Valley Water Reclamation Facility

Liberty Utilities employees volunteered to plant a pollinator garden in the Operator's Park in front of the Palm Valley Water Reclamation Facility (PVWRF). The pollinator garden is a certified Monarch Waystation and is part of Liberty Utilities' initiative to create sustainable habitats for monarch butterflies. Monarch butterflies are excellent pollinators, while also serving to protect crops from insects, making them essential to our ecosystem.





Planting pollinator gardens goes beyond helping to re-populate and protect the monarch population. The habitat created for these butterflies uses water-efficient plants, improves air and water quality, and provides an educational opportunity for all ages. In addition, the garden at PVWRF uses A+ quality treated recycled water from the plant, furthering conservation efforts.

The garden is open to the public during park hours of 8:00a.m. – 8:00p.m.

Spring Reminder! Change Your Landscape Watering!

With spring around the corner, it's time to start planning for changes to your landscape watering. Here's a guide to help you determine how much water your landscape needs.

To check that your plants are getting the right amount of water, use a soil moisture meter or a long screw driver to test the soil. A soil moisture meter has a scale that tells how dry or wet the soil is. If you don't have a soil moisture meter, you can use a long screwdriver and plunge it into the soil to ensure the moisture is 6 – 10 inches deep. This will help to ensure the plants aren't overwatered.

WAIER Landscape Watering WISELY. Guidelines		
How Much & How Often Water to the outer edge of the plant's canopy and to the depth indicated. Watering frequency will vary depending on season, plant type, weather and soil.		Days Between Waterings Spring Mar - May
Trees	Desert adapted	14-30 days
	High water use	7-12 days
Shrubs	Desert adapted	14-30 days
	High water use	7-10 days
Groundcovers & Vines	Desert adapted	14-30 days
	High water use	7-10 days
Cacti and Succulents		21-45 days
Annuals		3-7 days
Warm Season Grass		4-14 days
Cool Season Grass		3-7 days

While changing the frequency of watering, BEAT THE PEAK! Change the time the plants are watered to before 6a.m. or after 9p.m.

Wipes Clog. What NOT to Flush



"Flushable Wipes" should NOT be flushed down toilets. Even though these wipes may be labeled as "flushable" and are advertised to be "just like toilet paper," they actually cannot disintegrate in the sewer systems and can cause major blockages!

Since these wipes do not disintegrate easily or quickly, flushing them is like flushing a handkerchief or other item made of cloth.

Please partner with us and avoid flushing any type of wipe, "flushable" or otherwise, down the toilet. If you must use wipes, put them in the trash, not in the toilet.
