

"Flushable Wipes" should **NOT** be flushed down in toilets, even though these wipes may be labeled as "flushable" and are advertised to be "just like toilet paper" they actually cannot disintegrate in the sewer systems and can cause major blockages!

Since these wipes do not disintegrate easily or quickly, flushing them is like flushing a handkerchief or other item made of cloth.

Here is a list of items that should **NEVER** be flushed:

· Baby Wipes*

· Wet Wipes*

· Flushable Wipes*

· Cleaning Pads

· Feminine Hygiene Pads · Diapers

· O-Tips or Cotton Balls

· Pills

· Paper Towels or Tissues · Dental Floss

We want to partner with our communities in educating them about these types of wipes and clogs to avoid any type of sewer backups and damage to the sewer systems.

Please partner with us and avoid flushing any type of wipe, "flushable" or otherwise down the toilet.

*If you must use wipes, put them in the trash, not the toilet.
