

CORDES LAKES WELL #7

BACKGROUND

Prior to Liberty Utilities acquiring the Cordes Lakes water system, residents were often faced with drought stage water use restrictions and even rolling water outages. To address the water shortage problem the previous purveyors drilled a new well but it failed to produce adequate quantities of water.

Knowing the system required a new water source to address water shortages, specifically in the summer months, one of the first major infrastructure projects Liberty Utilities constructed was a new well, known as Well #7.
