

## HOA & Commercial Irrigation Efficiency Rebate

Liberty offers a rebate to help upgrade existing irrigation systems with more efficient technology for large landscape areas. Eligible upgrades include, but are not limited to, weather-based irrigation controllers (WBICs), spray sprinkler bodies, drip irrigation, rain sensors, and flow sensors.

#### **Eligibility**

- Homeowners associations (HOA), multi-family residential, schools, and commercial properties located
  within Liberty's water service area are eligible for this rebate. Applicant must be the owner of the
  property or have the permission of the owner to implement the specific conversion and to apply for
  and receive rebate funds. If the applicant is an HOA, it must be authorized by the HOA Board, and the
  applicant must be the Community/Property Manager or HOA president.
- New construction is **not** eligible.

### Rebate Information/Terms and Conditions

- Rebate covers up to 100% of the purchase cost, not to exceed \$10,000.
- Rebate covers water efficient technology only (WBIC's, sprinkler components, rain sensors, etc.).
  - Does NOT include installation, wiring, other parts, tax or shipping.
- Applicant must provide proof of existing technology before any upgrades are made.
- WBICs and sprinkler components must be EPA WaterSense Certified
  - o Components must be new and not refurbished.
  - Visit <u>epa.gov/watersense/product-search</u> to determine if a product is EPA WaterSense Certified or contact us with questions.

  - Photo(s) of the new equipment after installation.
    - Altered or false photos/receipts will result in denial.
    - All photos become the property of Liberty and may be used in program materials.
  - Submit itemized receipts showing:
    - Vendor or contractor name
    - Date of purchase or service
    - Make and model for equipment
- 4. A **post-installation inspection** may be required to verify completion.
