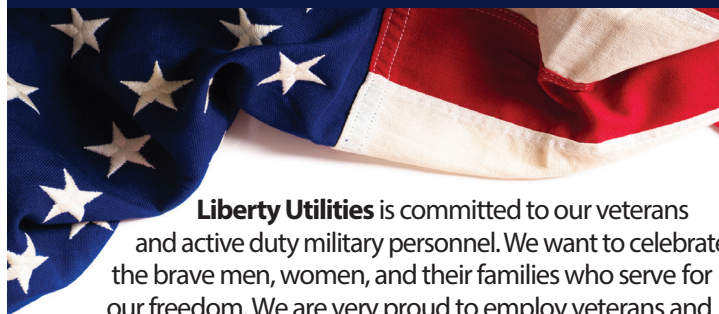

INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS

We have completed the pump test on the new well and are happy to report we have water! There are many steps in the process of building this new well, we anticipate the well will be completed prior to the start of next summer. In addition to the well, we have been working on a lot of infrastructure improvements to provide safe and reliable water services. Here are some of the projects we have completed:

Replaced

- 275 meters

Repaired

- 70 service lines
- 55 main breaks

Added

- 30 air relief valves
- 1 main
- 3 gate valves
- Added automated well monitoring equipment



With the winter months coming up, now is a good time to start prepping your home to prevent winter damage. Here are some tips for winter preparation:

- ▶ Wrap your pipes with insulation.
- ▶ Fix drafty windows and plug drafts around doors.
- ▶ Keep your home temperature set no lower than 55°F.
- ▶ Disconnect garden hoses and drain the water that remains in faucets.
- ▶ Know the location of and how to shut off your main water valve in case you have a pipe burst.
